McAllister Reminds Delinquent Taxpayers: Property Tax Bills Overdue

Notices have been mailed to over 37,000 taxpayers!

San Diego, CA... Dan McAllister, the County Treasurer-Tax Collector announced today that his office has begun mailing 37,887 **delinquent reminder notices** to taxpayers who failed to pay their first, second or both 2013-2014 property tax installments. The notices will reflect a 10% late fee and a \$10 cost redemption fee. The total amount due on these delinquent accounts is \$88,058,906.

“The good news is that number of delinquencies is down 10.2% compared to last year,” said McAllister. “The bad news is that these taxpayers will continue to accrue penalties if not paid by June 30th.”

Taxpayers have until **Monday, June 30, 2014** to pay their property taxes or an additional penalty of 1.5% per month or 18% per year will be added to their tax bill.

In September, 981,829 tax bills were mailed to San Diego County property owners. The 2013-2014 property tax bills are expected to generate \$4.8 billion.

Payments are due in two equal installments, on November 1st (delinquent after December 10th) and February 1st (delinquent after April 10th). Late payments automatically trigger late charges of 10% on the first installment payment; and an additional penalty of 10% plus a \$10 cost redemption fee is applied on the second installment if it is late.
