# Tax Collector Issues Last Shout Out: \$366k Still Unclaimed! *Deadline to claim: September 8, 2014*

*San Diego, CA* ...San Diego County Treasurer-Tax Collector Dan McAllister announced today that the deadline to review and claim the **Final Notice of the Unclaimed Monies list** is fast approaching. The Unclaimed funds, as of September 8, 2014, will be “escheated” to the County’s General Fund.

“Our countdown has started,” stated McAllister. “We are giving one last shout out to anyone that has done business with the County to check the list at [www.sdtreastax.com](http://www.sdtreastax.com) and see if they are owed any money. These funds will be property of the County after the Monday, September 8, 2014 deadline. I urge you to check the list.”

The County Treasurer-Tax Collector’s office now has **1,684 unclaimed accounts, which amount to approximately \$366,000 in funds available to claim.** The lowest amount available is \$10.11, and the highest is \$8,750 to a blood relative of Elizabeth Beal. In July, McAllister announced that his office had more than \$409,000 in refunds and was seeking owners of before the September deadline.

Current state law allows countywide monies that remain unclaimed for more than three years and property tax refunds that are unclaimed for more than four years to be turned over to the County’s General Fund.
