County Treasurer seeks owners of \$1.3 million in unclaimed funds!

San Diego, CA ...San Diego County Treasurer-Tax Collector Dan McAllister announced today that his office is seeking parties who may be entitled to refunds, including property taxpayers and others who may have previously owned property in the County of San Diego in the past five years. The **Unclaimed Monies list** can be viewed at www.sdtreastax.com, and includes refunds to individuals and entities who have: (1) applied for an assessment appeal; (2) previously owned a business and real estate associated with it; or (3) sold property through a short sale. Title companies and developers are also listed for refunds associated with properties they previously represented.

“We have a large number of refunds available to claim this year,” stated McAllister. “Our goal is to find the rightful owners. I urge people to check the Unclaimed Monies list and claim their monies today. Refunds and notices have been sent to the last known mailing address for each refund owed. However, we have received returned notices and some checks have not been cashed.”

The County Treasurer-Tax Collector’s office has **4,329 unclaimed accounts, which amount to approximately \$1.3 million in funds available to claim.** The lowest amount available is \$10.01, and the highest is \$9,984.

Current state law allows property tax refunds to be turned over to the County’s General Fund if they are unclaimed for more than four years.
